"You will recall that your mother used to make an interesting adaptation of this idea [of remembering the Lord by wearing frontlets between the eyes of the Israelites]. When she sent you out on an important errand, the purpose of which she did not want you to forget, she helped you to remember by tying a red string on your finger with a bow on the top so that no matter where you went or what you did, you would always remember what your mother wanted you to do. And that is about what the Lord did to the children of Israel"
