

### Questions to Ponder

### Isaiah 42: 8-12

8) "I *am* the LORD: that *is* my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.

**9) Behold, the former things are come to pass, and new things do I declare: before they spring forth I tell you of them.**

10) Sing unto the LORD a new song, *and* his praise from the end of the earth, ye that go down to the sea, and all that is therein; the isles, and the inhabitants thereof.

11) Let the wilderness and the cities thereof lift up *their voice*, the villages *that* Kedar doth inhabit: let the inhabitants of the rock sing, let them shout from the top of the mountains.

12) Let them give glory unto the LORD, and declare his praise in the islands."



The "new things" about which Isaiah speaks foretell the coming of the Messiah, Jesus Christ, Our Savior, whose life, atonement, and resurrection will give all the world a "new song" to sing of eternal glory.
